



# PRC Jobsite Safety Orientation

Job # – Job Name

1. Hard hats, safety footwear, and safety glasses are required to be worn 100% of the time while on the job site. All other Personal Protection Equipment (PPE) shall be worn as required by OSHA standards.
2. Smoking is prohibited within project building(s), construction office(s), and all other facilities related to this project. Smoking is only allowed at locations as determined by the Superintendent.
3. No firearms, weapons, or explosives are allowed on the jobsite. Concealed Weapons Permits (CCW) do not apply to this jobsite. Police will be notified to remove any individual who violates this policy.
4. The use of illegal drugs or alcohol while on the project shall be cause for immediate removal from the project. Inform your supervisor if you are taking strong prescription drugs that warn against driving or using machinery. PRC's Safety/Drug Testing Policy has NOT changed due to any legalized prescription marijuana law.
5. Any worker suspected of being under the influence of drugs or alcohol or is found to have caused an accident will be subject to immediate screening.
6. Only trained and certified operators shall be allowed to operate equipment. Operators shall provide a copy of their certifications to the superintendent prior to starting any work.
7. In an emergency, exit the building and assemble at a pre-determined location for a head count.
8. Immediately report all chemical and oil spills and any suspected hazardous materials to the superintendent.
9. Daily Hot Work Permits are required to be completed by the sub-contractor supervisor and Superintendent on a DAILY basis for any and all flame and/or spark-producing work.
10. Personnel working at heights 6' or greater without fall protection will be immediately removed from the project for 24 hours. Personnel found to be repeat fall protection safety violators will result in permanent removal from the project.
11. Ensure you follow the proper Lock-out Tag-Out procedures and discuss the plan with site management.
12. Ensure you close gates and fences behind you entering and exiting the site.
13. You are responsible for keeping your work area free of debris. Clean-up will be done on a daily basis.
14. All extension cords will be suspended to avoid creating tripping hazards and housekeeping problems in major routes of access and egress.
