



PRC Jobsite Safety Orientation

Job # - Job Name

1. All work must comply with OSHA standards, applicable regulations, & PRC safety policies.
2. Hard hats and safety glasses must be worn at all times while on site. High-visibility vests or garments are required unless otherwise directed by the PRC Project Team. Use additional PPE as needed per OSHA standards and specific jobsite conditions.
3. Appropriate attire is required at all times, including hard-soled boots, long pants, and shirts with sleeves.
4. Smoking is prohibited inside all project buildings, construction offices, and related facilities. Smoke, eat, and drink only in designated areas approved by the PRC Superintendent.
5. Firearms, explosives, and other weapons are strictly prohibited on site. Concealed Carry Permits do not apply.
6. The use, sale, or possession of illegal drugs or alcohol on site will result in immediate removal. Prescription drugs that impair work must be reported to your supervisor.
7. Professional behavior is expected at all times. Fighting, gambling, theft, horseplay, and the use of profane or abusive language are strictly prohibited.
8. Immediately report all accidents, injuries, unsafe conditions, or spills to the PRC Superintendent.
9. Complete a daily Hot Work Permit for any spark- or flame-producing activity. Keep a fire extinguisher within 50 feet. Store flammables in approved safety containers.
10. Only trained and/or qualified personnel may operate equipment or machinery on site. Training must comply with OSHA standards and manufacturer requirements. Unauthorized operation of any equipment is strictly prohibited.
11. Fall protection is required at heights of 6' or more. Violations will result in removal from the project; repeat offenders will be permanently removed. Safety rails/cables may only be removed with PRC approval and must be reinstalled immediately. Personal fall arrest systems must meet OSHA and ANSI requirements.
12. Follow all Lockout/Tagout procedures when servicing, maintaining, or performing work on energized equipment.
13. Use of designated bathroom facilities or porta-johns is mandatory. Urinating or defecating at the Project site in any undesignated area, including the use of bottles, is strictly prohibited. Violation of this rule shall be a basis for immediate removal of offending personnel from the Project site, and the Subcontractor shall be assessed a penalty of \$250 for each offense.
14. Maintain a clean and organized work area. Daily cleanup is required.
15. Inspect all electrical cords and cables before use. Damaged or defective cords must be removed from service immediately. All extension cords must be suspended or routed to prevent tripping hazards and maintain clear access routes.
16. The use of earbuds, headphones, or personal music devices is not permitted on site.
